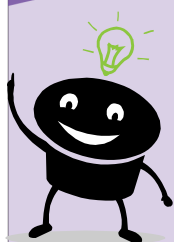

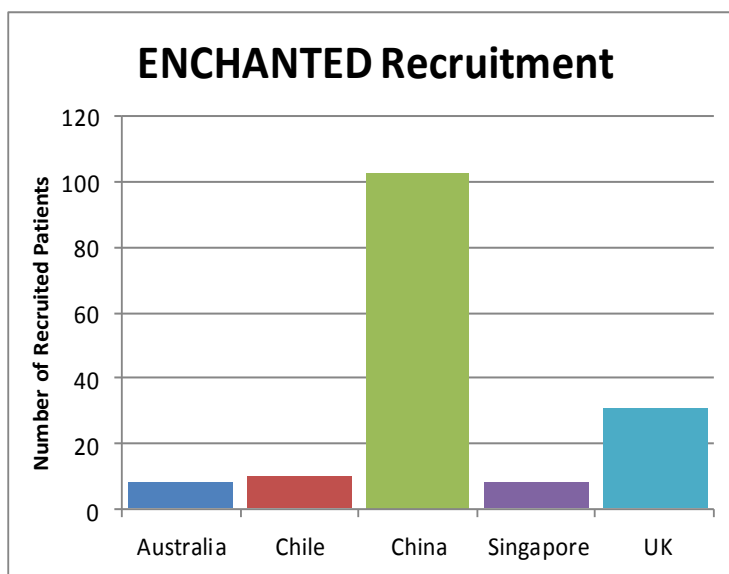
A Star Event
